BEULAH AT A GLANCE

LOCATION

Beulah is a city in Mercer County, North Dakota, located at the junction of Highways 200 and 49 and within about a 90-minute drive of Bismarck, Minot, and Dickinson.

FOUNDED

Beulah was founded in 1914 (named after Beulah Stinchcombe).

POPULATION

About 3,050 (U.S. Census Bureau estimate, 2024).

ENERGY IDENTITY

Often referred to as the “Energy Capital of North Dakota,” with major power and energy operations shaping the region.

SYNFUELS LANDMARK

The Great Plains Synfuels Plant is the only commercial-scale coal gasification facility in the U.S. that manufactures natural gas.

POWER GENERATION

Antelope Valley Station has two 450-MW units (900 MW total), operating since 1984 and 1986.

MINING

Coteau’s Freedom Mine produces about 11.5–13.5 million tons of lignite coal annually and is considered one of the nation’s largest lignite mines

LAKE ACCESS

Beulah Bay sits on the south shore of Lake Sakakawea and is a hub for boating, fishing, swimming, water skiing, and picnicking. It’s a favorite spot for easy lake access and laid-back weekends.

OUTDOOR RECREATION

Beulah blends prairie scenery with community parks and outdoor spaces, plus the area is known for its scenic valley views and wildlife.

DINING AND LOCAL SHOPPING

Local restaurants, cafés, and small businesses make it easy to grab a meal, stock up, or find a hometown favorite.

EVENTS AND COMMUNITY

Year-round community events, seasonal celebrations, and small-town hospitality make Beulah a great place to visit and stay awhile.

NEW DEVELOPMENT

A former mine site near Beulah is planned to be repurposed for Talon Metals’ proposed minerals processing facility (about 256 acres, with an associated rail spur). Signals new investment and jobs tied to the battery supply chain.

HISTORY OF BEULAH

Early Settlement and Railroad Days (1910s):

Beulah, originally known as Troy, was established in 1914 as a railroad town, helping drive regional development through transportation and trade.

Coal Mining Boom (1920s-1950s):

Coal mining became a major industry in Beulah, fueling the area’s growth as workers flocked to the town for employment.

Creation of Lake Sakakawea (1950s-1960s):

The construction of the Garrison Dam created Lake Sakakawea, boosting tourism and recreation in Beulah.

Known for: Walleye, northern pike, smallmouth bass, and salmon, with excellent fishing year-round.

Description: Offers boat ramps, camping, and easy access to Lake Sakakawea. Ideal for walleye and northern pike fishing.

• Dakota Waters Resort •

Distance: ~14 miles northwest of Beulah

Description: A full-service resort offering cabins, RV sites, boat rentals, and a marina. Known for walleye, northern pike, and bass fishing, with family-friendly amenities and stunning lakeside views.

MISSOURI RIVER:

Distance: Connects with Lake Sakakawea near Beulah

Fish: Great for channel catfish, sauger, and seasonal fishing around the Sakakawea area.

WHAT TO HUNT AND WHEN

Big Game

Deer (Whitetail and Mule):

Archery: September 1 - December 6

Firearm: November 8 - 24

Muzzleloader: December 6 - 22

Turkey Spring Season: April 14 - May 19 (for both male and female turkeys - permits required)

Small Game

Squirrels (Eastern gray squirrels and Fox squirrels):

Season: September 1 - January 31

Pheasants (Ring-necked pheasants):

Season: October 12 - January 5

Waterfowl

Duck and Regular Goose:

September 28 - December 8

Furbearers

Coyotes, Foxes, and Raccoons:

Season: October 12 - March 15

These dates may vary slightly each year, so it's important to verify the specific dates on the North Dakota Game and Fish Department website or through local regulations to ensure accuracy before planning your hunt.

WHERE TO HUNT

Public Land:

There are numerous Wildlife Management Areas (WMAs) and State Trust Lands around Beulah, ideal for hunting various species. These areas are accessible for both residents and non-residents.

Private Land:

Many landowners in Beulah allow hunting, especially for waterfowl, so it's best to get permission before hunting on private property.

Hunting Clubs:

For those interested in shooting practice or hunting guidance, Zap Sportsman Club offers excellent facilities to sharpen shooting skills. (7 miles NW of Beulah).

HUNTING LICENSES AND PERMITS

- **License:** A valid hunting license is required, issued by the North Dakota Game and Fish Department.
- **Fees:** Costs vary based on residency (resident or non-resident).
- **Special Permits:** Waterfowl hunting requires a state stamp; big game hunts need additional permits.

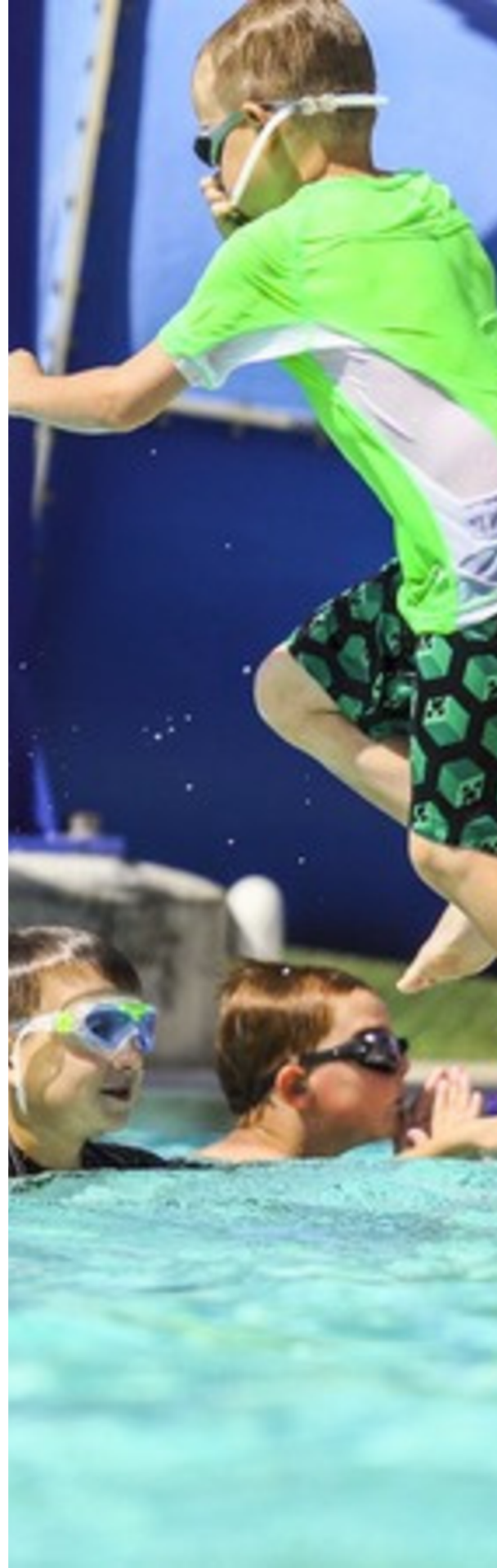

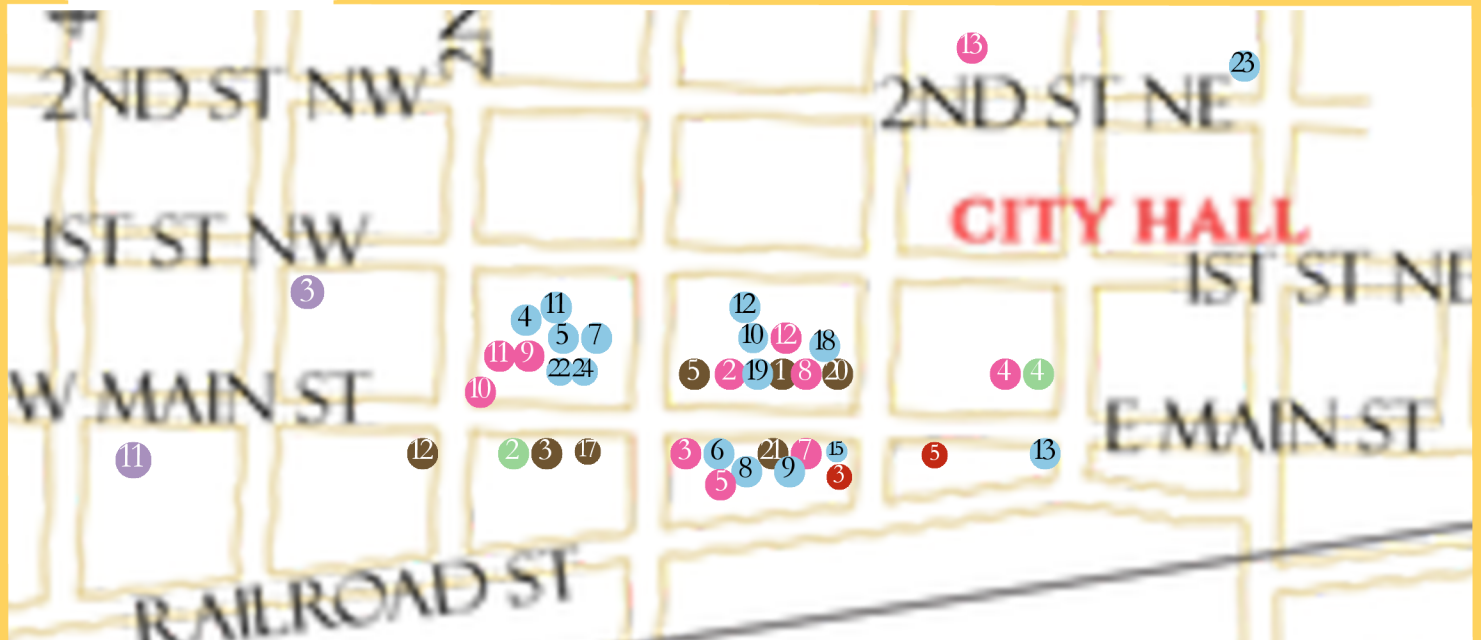

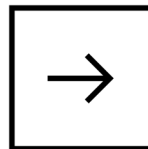
